- I have looked into the three matters about which you recently maked mo.
- 1) Indochinese piastre banknotes are convertible at the Banque de l'Indochine in France at a rate of 17 france to 1 piastre. Convertibility is limited to travelers returning to France from Indochina and to those individuals or companies which are engaged in business with Indochina. The piastre, officially 20 to the U.S. dollar, is, I am informed, selling at between 55 and 60 to the U.S. dollar in the free market.
- 2) The purchase, sale or possession of gold in the United States is strictly circumscribed and regulated by law and regulation. It is legal, however, for anyone in the United States to buy and sell gold, for domestic or foreign account, which is physically located outside the United States. Hence, the purchase or sale in the United States of stock certificates, bearer or nominative, evidencing ownership of a stated quantity of gold situated outside the United States is legal. The current price of bar gold, Zurich, is circa 37.75 per fine os.
- 3) The conversion of certain foreign banknotes (U.S., British, Prench, Swiss, Belgian, Egyptian) into DM may be made in West Germany at the official rate of such banknotes. There is no limitation upon the amount of such banknotes which may be brought into West Germany.

MEMORANDUM

At 10:30 a.m. Special Agent A. L. Gucker of the Albany Office telephoned and said that ITZHAK VARDI and MAURICE J. DISKIN were driving on their way to New York City from Abany in a green 1950 Chevrolet convertible coupe, license 1F4456, which is registered to DISKIN at 8735 Bay Parkway, Brooklyn, New York. DISKIN purchased the car in Albany, apparently, it having been registered there in March, 1952. They were travelling down Route 9W and would apparently enter New York City on the West Side Highway. They were under the surveillance of Albany Agents Bagley and Piper, who would call the New York Office when they brought DISKIN and VARDI into the city.

Agent Gucker said that RAFELLI and VARDI were checked while in Albany and did not appear to be making any significant contacts. They seemed to be legitimately occupied with the Israeli bond campaign. Albany had been checking them through established sources and spot checks.

VARDI and DISKIN undoubtedly were going to return to Albany after the weekend. RAFELLI was still in Albany. While in Albany DISKIN did not stay at the same hotel with RAFELLI and VARDI, but did work with them.



SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:

JOSEPH RAFELLI, with VARDI and VARDI's wife, arrived Utica, New York, January 29, 1952. Stayed until February 7, 1952, at which time they left by train for Buffalo, New York. RAFELLI, and VARDI returned to Utica from Buffalo, 2/21/52 and stayed until 2/24/52, and then left for New York City. On 3/15/52, RAFELLI returned to Utica, leaving for Albany 3/16/52. Again returned to Utica 3/25/52 from Syracuse, N. Y. and returned to Syracuse early morning 3/27/52. While in Utica, N.Y. RAFELLI contacted Rabbi JEROME LIPNICK, Temple Beth-El, and other prominent persons of Jewish extraction, allegedly for purpose of raising funds for private enterprise for country of Israel. RAFELLI and VARDI spent the approximate period 3/3/52 through 3/22/52 at Albany, N. Y. except for the week-end of March 15 and 16, 1952 which VARDI spent in New York City and RAFELLI spent in Utica, N. Y. During this period they made about thirty-seven contacts, mostly in Albany, Schenectady and Troy, N. Y., including sixteen businessmen, four professional men, two Rabbis, two employees of the General Electric Company at Schenectady, New York. Others were S. C. MURRAY, another employee of the Palestine Economic Corp., and MAURICE J. DISKIN of the United Jewish Appeal of New York City who spent

He stated that he learned that RAFELLI had been in Germany with the United States Military Government from 1944 to 1945 and continued there until 1951, when the State Department took over. advised, he stated, that RAFELLI had no official connection now, but was interested in private enterprise development. He said that he had heard that RAFELLI had stated that Haifa is a very good harbor and private investments could help to strengthen it as a bulwark for the West. It was also ascertained by T-2 that one MARTIN ABELOVE, whose name is set out above, has been interested for some years in Israeli investments and has recently returned from Palestine.





RESIDENCES AND APPARENT PURPOSE OF SUBJECTS VISIT TO BUFFALO

T-1, of known reliability, stated that on the afternoon of February 7, 1952, the individual who registered as JOSEPH RAFFAELI was assigned Room 1063 at the Hotel Statler and Mr. and Mrs. VARDI were given Room 1224. According to T-1, all of these individuals gave addresses as Palestine Economic Corporation, 400 Madison Avenue, New York City.

T-3, of known reliability, stated that on February 8, 1952, RAFELLI had a business discussion with someone concerning his business in Buffalo. RAFELLI is reported to have discussed, among other things, the procedure of accepting notes as payment for stock subscriptions. RAFELLI advised that stock certificates are to be issued as the note is paid off. T-3 further advised that RAFELLI mentioned that he called Dr. KAPLAN on the preceding night and a certain matter was straightened out. RAFELLI also said that he had a "good day" on that date and has a "string of meetings lined up". Among individuals he said he saw on that date were MAX YELLEN, LEO ROSEN, and "The Executive Director of the Federation Bureau". RAFELLI was also reported to have said that about eight to ten persons in Buffalo will have "Parlor Meetings". RAFELLI expressed the desire of getting \$100,000.00 out of Buffalo.

T-3 said that RAFELLI desired to get committees of local people to help and he pointed out that he has never before raised an investment fund. According to RAFELLI, the following individuals will be the central point of the drive: the "Executive Secretary of the Federation, Judge DIAMOND, and LEO ROSEN".

As set out in another section of this report, RAFELLI on February 7, 1952, prior to the aforementioned discussion had made contact with the Law Office of LEO ROSEN who is an attorney in Room 1228 of the Prudential Building It will also be noted he visited the Law Office of MAX YELLEN at 162 Mohawk Street.

Concerning "Judge DIAMOND" mentioned above, this person is probably identical with the former New York State Supreme Court Judge, DAVID DIAMOND about whom the files of the Buffalo office disclose the following pertinent information:

T-4, of known reliability, during July, 1944, stated that he considered DAVID DIAMOND then to be an active member of the Communist Political Association in Buffalo.

The Communist Political Association has been cited by the Attorney General as coming within the purview of Executive Order 9835.

T-5, of known reliability, on February 21, 1945, stated that while in Communist Political Association Headquarters in Buffalo a short time before, MAIA JAMES, known to the informant to be the Administrative and Organizational Secretary of the Communist Political Association, made the remark that DAVE DL.MOND was actually a member of the CPA.

T-6, of known reliability, stated that on May 23, 1945, while at CP/ Headquarters, the informant observed a letter addressed to SAM COLEMAN, known to the informant to be the Chairman of the Erie County CPA. The letter was written by DAVID DIAMOND and in it he enclosed an application for membership in a certain civic group. The informant mentioned at this time that DIAMOND was not a member of the CPA but perhaps could be classified as a "Communist sympathizer". Informant said that he had never seen DAVID DIAMOND at any CPA functions. T-6 stated that on several occasions, he heard SAM COLEMAN call DAVID DIAMOND a "good guy". According to the informant, COLEMAN uses this term to describe persons with whom he gets along on matters of "mutual interest". Informant advised that information had come to his attention that about five or six years prior to this period, DAVID DIAMOND had used his influence whereby the Communist Party was permitted to hold public meetings in Buffalo.

T-7, of known reliability, in July of 1946, stated that LOYD KINSTY, known to the informant to be the Erie County CP Chairman, stated on July 30, 1946 that DAVE DIAMOND was going to handle the legal work for the CP Election Committee in Buffalo.

The "Buffalo Evening News" in its editorial on November 25, 1947, stated that DAVID DIAMOND was on a "partial unofficial list of sponsors" of a meeting planned for December 11, 1947 under the auspices of the Buffalo Chapter of the Progressive Citizens of America, which was to be addressed by HENRY AGARD WALLICE, a Presidential candidate.

The Progressive Citizens of America has been cited as a "new and broader Communist front for the entire United States, formed in September, 1946 at the direction of "Communist steering committees" from the "Communist-dominated National Citizens Political Action Committee" and the Independent Citizens Committee of the Arts, Sciences and Professions. This citation appeared in the California Committee on UnAmerican Activities, Reports, 1947, page 369 and 1948, page 354.

T-8, of known reliability, stated that on June 28, 1949, CHARIES DOYLE, believed by the informant to be a member of the Communist Party, had asked DAVID DIAMOND for assistance in sponsoring a Civil Rights Conference to be held in New York City but DIAMOND was reported to have replied that he could not lend his name to anything at that time.

The Executive Secretary of the "Federation" mentioned by RAFELLI undoubtedly refers to ARTHUR S. ROSICHAN, the Executive Director of the Buffalo Federation for Social Service, Root Building, who resides at 745 West Delevan. Contacts with this person by RAFELLI and VARDI are subsequently set forth in this report.

T-9, of known reliability, stated that on February 9, 1952 during a discussion of business activities in Buffalo, RAFELLI again made mention of "Judge DIAMOND". The informant said that among other things, RAFELLI mentioned that Utica has proven their theory which is a sound one inasmuch as they walked out of that city with \$50,000.00 in sales but not all of which were cash. RAFELLI is also reported to have mentioned that the office in New York was annoyed about something and that he intends to organize on a national scale. He said that it is possible that they will have to stay two or three years "here". He mentioned that they were merely laying the ground work now, lining up people with whom they can work, or holding parlor meetings and also luncheon meetings.

T-10, of known reliability, stated that on February 11, 1952, JOSEPH E. RAFFAELI, who gave his address as "Care of Palestine Economic Corporation, 400 Madison, New York City" registered at the Lafayette Hotel in Buffalo and was assigned Room 162. T-10 also advised that ITZHAK and Mrs. VARDI also registered at the same time. They also gave their address as 400 Madison, New York City and their same connection as "PEC". They were assigned Room 110.

T-10 stated that on February 13, 1952, Mr. and Mrs. G. MARGALIT, West End Avenue, New York City, registered at the Hotel Lafayette and that the reservation had been made for them on the preceding day by RAFELLI.

In this connection on February 20, 1952, the New York Office advised that the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service at New York City had no record of G. MARGALIT. New York also advised that the New York Telephone Directory does not disclose a G. MARGALIT residing on West End Avenue.

T-3 stated that on February 13, 1952, RAFELLI mentioned that at the rate they had been going during the past two weeks, they were "operating on a basis of one million a year, fourteen thousand in Utica".

T-13, of known reliability, stated that on February 11, 1952, RAFELLI, in discussing his business operations, mentioned an individual who sent him a check for \$1,000.00, another person who also sent a check and a person named ROSENBERG who had held to meetings and who will see RAFELLI in mid April, 1952.

T-10 stated that on February 16, 1952, a couple who were acquainted with RAFFILI and VARDI registered at the Hotel Lafayette as Mr. and Mrs. SIDNEY GEFFEN, 2611 Genesee Street, Utica, New York and were assigned to Room 250.

On the afternoon of February 16, 1952, SAS CARL R. THACKSTON, JAMES M. BEAKDSLEY and the writer observed that the GEFFENS, the VARDIS, the MARGALITS and RAFELLI went on a sightseeing tour of Niagara Falls, New York.

According to T-10, on the same date the Lafayette Hotel received a piece of mail postmarked February 14, 1952, New York City, which was addressed to Mr. JOSEPH RAFFAELI. This piece of mail bore the return address of Apartment 41, 9 West 73rd Street, New York City.

T-9, of known reliability, stated that on the morning of February 17, 1952, RAFELLI and a person believed to be SIDNEY GEFFEN had a discussion concerning RAFELLI's stock sales and business transactions. T-9 said that they talked about forming their own company and about how it would have to be a "Palestine company or corporation". They reportedly mentioned getting an article in every Jewish paper and organizing the business throughout the entire country. T-9 got the impression that RAFELLI and another person have put up an amount of money and they desire GEFFEN to match it. RAFELLI stated on this occasion that he would like to get a house for himself and his wife. RAFELLI also spoke of needing financial help. A person believed to be GEFFEN is reported to have stated that his future with Israel has been on his mind.

Through the cooperation of T-10 the contents of a telegram which was sent by RAFELLI on February 17, 1952 were secured. The telegram was sent to Mrs. F. FEIGELRAUM, 180 Cabrina Boulevard, 'New York City. It read as follows:

"Please ask Mr. APPLEB.UN of AT Fashions to send express special delivery collect all my astragate stones together with his observations and ideas of the subject. Would like samples to reach me not later Wednesday at Hotel Lafayette, Buffalo, New York. Will see you in New York next week. Love JOSEPH RAFFELELI".

On February 19, 1952, the Washington Field Office advised that the

files of that office contain no information identifiable with Mrs. F. FEICELBAUN and Mr. APPLEBAUM. The Washington Field Office also advised that it had no information indicating the significance of the above mentioned telegram:

On February 20, 1952, the New York Office advised that the name "Mrs. F. FEIGELBAUM" mentioned in the above telegram should be YAFFA FEIGELBAUM, inasmuch as telephone directory reflects YAFFA FEIGELBAUM at 180 Cabrini Boulevard, New York City. New York also stated that the files of this office contain no information concerning YAFFA FEIGELBAUM nor anything that could be identified with Mr. APPLEBAUM.

T-16, of known reliability, stated that on February 18, 1952, RAFELLI made the statement to VARDI, part of which contained the following information:

"SAM SAPOWITZ - 425 shares | WEINSTEIN - 425 shares | WEINSTEIN - 425 shares | WILLIAM SERMOFFSKY, - 425 shares".

Through the cooperation of T-10, it was learned that RAFELLI on February 18, 1952 sent the following telegram:

"AVNON RAFFAELI, 55 Shedertken, Tel Aviv, Israel Congratulations assignment all luck birth love Nitas son named Alter dash work progressing well Joe"

With regard to this telegram, T-17, of known reliability, another confidential agency which conducts security and personnel investigations, stated that on one occasion RAFELII advised he had a son-in-law who was an Israeli Government official and who was expecting a consulor position in the United States.

Through T-10 it was learned that on February 17, 1952, RAFELLI reserved a room at the Lafayette Hotel for an individual who on February 18, 1952 registered as SAMUEL NEAMAN, PE Corporation, 400 Madison, New York City. He was assigned Room 417.

It was also ascertained through T-10 that Mr. and Mrs. G. MARGALIT checked out of the Hotel Lafayette on the morning of February 20, 1952 and according to T-10, they apparently intended to catch immediately a plane for New York.

T-18, of known reliability, furnished the following information.

RAFELLI and VARDI received an inter-office communication from HERBERT WIESENTHAL of the Palestine Economics Committee, 400 Madison, New York City wherein WIESENTHAL advised RAFELLI and VARDI to contact Dr. REUBEN COHEN, 485 Main Street, Buffalo and attempt to interest him in a subscription. COHEN was reportedly recommended to WIESENTHAL by A. DAVID SCHEINMAN of Pittsburgh, Pa. and it was pointed out that any commission earned by the sale of such subscription would necessarily have to be split between RAFELLI and HARRY KRONENGOLD.

T-18 further advised that attached to this inter-office communication was a letter directed to Dr. REUSEN COHEN from HARRY KRONENGOLD in order to explain the organization and purpose of the Palestine Economic Corporation. According to this letter, the Palestine Economic Corporation was established in 1926 and its founders included such noted Jewish leaders as Senator HERBERT LEHMAN, now PEC's Honorary Chairman; ROBERT SZOLD, presently Chairman of PEC Board; and BERNARD FLEXNER, NATHAN STRAUS, FELIX M. WARBURG, LOUIS MARSHALL, are other Board members. T-18 further stated that in KRONENCOID's letter he mentioned that PEC in connection with the General Tire and Rubber Company, Akron, Chio, is presently establishing a two and one-half million dollar plant in Israel. He said that other agreements have been made with the International General Electric Company and the Aluminum Corporation of America for distribution of their products in Israel.

According to KRONENGOID, the Hudson Pulp and Paper Corporation has also been induced to crect a three million dollar paper mill known as the "American-Israeli Paper Mills, Limited in Israel. KRONENGOID concluded his correspondence with COHEN by pointing out PEC's need for large amounts of additional capital for the furtherance of economic assistance to Israel such as explained above. He stated that PEC basically serves as a channel whereby Americans invest their money to work in Israel.

SAS FRANCIS D. CONNERS and JAMES L. DENZEL observed that RAFELLI, the VARDIS and NEAMAN checked out of the Hotel Lafayette on February 21, 1952. At the New York Central Railroad Terminal NEAMAN was observed by SA CHARLES A. FERGUSON to enter a gate leading to a train bound for Chicago. A physical surveillance conducted by SA CONNERS and SA DENZEL on the same date disclosed that after boarding the train at Buffalo, RAFELLI and the VARDIS got off at Utica, New York where they registered at the Hotel Utica at 5:30 P.M. on February 2, 1952.

On April 24, 1952, T-19, of known reliability, advised that RAFELLI was not then residing in the Hotel Statler, Buffalo, New York.



On the same date, T-10 stated that RAFEILI was not at the time residing at the Lafayette Hotel, Buffalo. T-10 produced a letter which he said had recently been received by the hotel. It was addressed to JOSEPH RAFFAELI in care of the hotel with a request to forward it. The return address bore the following:

"N. R. MEADOWS, Department of State, U.S.A., Washington, D.C."

The envelope was not franked but appeared to be an envelope of the Department of State. The word "official" was struck out.

T-6 in November, 1945, stated that during a meeting of the Financial Committee of the Communist Party held in Buffalo on November 8, 1945, the name SOL LENZNER of the Queen-O Bottling Works was raised as a contributor to the Party. One of the CP members present said that LENZNER was the man who offered to pay for leaflets printed by the local CP as long as he had the opportunity tf approving the contents of the leaflets. It was stated at the meeting that GERTRUDE HAESSLER, known to the informants as a long time Party member, had made the approach to LENZNER concerning printing the leaflets because he was an "old timer" in the Communist Movement.

According to the agents, about twelve individuals left this address after the meeting was apparently over and drove away in automobiles which, according to the Buffalo Police Department, were registered in New York State as follows:

The Euffalo files contain no pertinent information concerning EKNEST FREUDENHEIM but with regard to Mrs. ERNEST FREUDENHEIM, the following is noted:

T-lh, of known reliability, stated that in September, 1947, Mrs. ERNEST S. FREUDENHEIM of 495 Lafayette Avenue was a member of the Win-The-Peace Conference, otherwise known as the National Committee to Win the Peace. It is noted that the National Committee to Win the Peace has been cited by the Attorney General as coming within the purview of Executive Order 9835.

T-15, of known reliability, in December, 1948 stated that he was in receipt of information that JOHN NOTO, the Western New York Sub-District CP Chairman, contacted BARBARA SHCRE, known to the informant to be an active CP member, NOTO reportedly asked SHORE to prepare a list of people in the American Labor Party and the Third Party who would be interested in the New York State Council for Legislative Action which at the time was setting up state-wide branches.

The informant had no other information with regard to the New York State Council for Legislative Action. With regard to the American Labor Party, T-4 and T-5 have advised that in the Buffalo area it is under the control and domination of the Communist Party.
