Tom Gerard, suspected of selling police secrets, says FBI spy probe a 'witch hunt'

Tom Gerard, the former San Francisco poice officer and ClA agent accused of selling law enforcement accrets to foreign powers, says he's the target of "the biggest witch hunt and wild goose chase I've ever seen."

The investigation originated with the FBI and now involves "friends and guys I've worked with (in the SFPD) for 25 years." Geroru said in an exclusive, sometimes tearful, interview with The Examiner from his hideaway in the Philippines.

"The sons of bitches are trying to put me in prison for the rest of my life." he said. "That's why I decided to leave the country. As long as I sit here, they can't get me."

Gerard says he believes that the FBI's loss of a file on the Black Muslim organization may be motivating the case against him, but that he is unnocent of any crime involving the sale of information.

Telephone wiretaps may show him taiking about: sharing police data with informanta, investigators or even foreign consulates. Gerard aumits. Still, he says, he has only done what he thought appropriate for a police officer.

Other factors have forced him into the unaccustomed role as chief suspect — and out of the country

"What they're (the FBI) thinking is they've got someone inside their own organization" giving outfiles, charged Gerard, who suddenly flee to the Philippines and turned in his retirement papers atage 60 after being questioned by the FBI.
